Two arrested for operating meth lab

Two people were arrested after a search of their residence at 1104 St. Vincent in Shreveport uncovered ingredients used to make meth.

Agents with the Caddo-Shreveport Street Level Interdiction Unit conducted the search on Tuesday, May 29. When they arrived at the house, a man and woman fled but were quickly detained at the rear of the residence. Chemicals and components of a meth lab were located on the second floor during a search of the residence.

A chemical disposal company was called to the scene to take custody of the chemicals. The suspects, identified as <u>William McDonald</u> and <u>Kami Thorn</u>, were booked into the Shreveport City Jail for Operation of a Clandestine Lab.
