

Ten cited for selling alcohol to minors

An investigation into the illegal sale of alcohol to underage persons resulted in 10 summons being issued, said Caddo Sheriff Steve Prator.

On Friday, December 20, the Sheriff's Youth Services Division checked 33 businesses for compliance with state laws and parish ordinances. Ten clerks were issued summonses for the unlawful sale of alcohol to persons under 21. One clerk was also issued a summons for not having an ABO card.
