

Two arrests made following Internet Task Force investigations

Caddo Parish Sheriff Steve Prator announced two arrests made by the Northwest Louisiana Internet Crimes against Childrenâ€™s Task Force.

Caddo Sheriffâ€™s Task Force agents Robert Greer, Jill Jones and Nicole Nitts arrested Christopher Powell, 25, of Montgomery, after Powell made contact on-line with a person whom he believed to be a 13-year-old female and arranged a meeting with her while visiting a friend in Shreveport. Agents arrested Powell and charged him with two counts of computer-aided solicitation and two counts of indecent behavior with a juvenile.

Agents also conducted a short-term investigation leading to the arrest of Carlos Billadicencio, 31, of Shreveport. He allegedly had inappropriate conversations on-line with a person whom he believed to be a 14-year-old female. The Task Force agents posing as the juvenile female arranged a meeting place where Billadicencio was taken into custody. Billadicencio was charged with computer-aided solicitation, indecent behavior with a juvenile, and attempted felony carnal knowledge of a juvenile.

Both Powell and Billadicencio were booked into the Caddo Correctional Center.
