Intruder Alert: Active Shooter - March 4, 2016

Lt. Col. Dave Grossman, noted expert on active shootings, will present a symposium at Centenary College's Marjorie Lyons Playhouse on how to manage an intruder in an institutional setting. Grossman has made revolutionary contributions to our understanding of killing in war, the psychological costs of war, the root causes of the current "virus" of violent crime that is raging around the world, and the process of healing the victims of violence in war and peace. His book, On Combat, is required reading for US Marines as well as FBI Academy and other colleges.
