- Twelve Mile Bayou is expected to crest today or tonight. Caddo Lake should crest today. Red River crested today. Cross Lake and Wallace Lake are continuing to slowly fall.
- Citizens can begin the recovery process with FEMA by registering in advance either at the FEMA website, <u>www.disasterassistance.gov</u>, or by phone at 1-800-621-3362.
- Continue to report damages in Caddo Parish to the Caddo Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness at 675-2255 or <u>reportdamages@caddosheriff.org</u>. So far over 422 addresses have been registered.
