

Caddo Sheriff offers teen course on distracted and impaired driving prevention

Caddo Sheriff Steve Prator will host two opportunities for young drivers to attend a safe driving program at Sheriff's Safety Town this month. The program will focus on the dangers of distracted and impaired driving.

The safety course will cover distractions including texting, cell phones, and music, and different forms of impairment such as alcohol and drug use. Part of the course includes operating an electric vehicle while wearing impairment goggles that simulate the effects of driving under the influence, Prator said.

The class will be offered April 12 from 4:30 - 6 p.m. and April 27 from 4 - 5:30 p.m. Participants must have either a valid driver's license or learner's permit. The course is limited to 20 participants, so pre-registration is required.
