

Boy Scouts accepting Caddo Sheriff's Camp applications

Sheriff Steve Prator announced today that applications are being accepted for this summer's Caddo Sheriff's Camp.

The overnight camp for boys ages 9-12 will be held at Kinsey Scout Reservation June 12-15. It is conducted by the Sheriff's Office and the Boy Scouts of America, Norwela Council.

The camp recognizes at-risk Caddo Parish boys for good behavior and academic achievement and introduces them to the scouting program. The purpose of the camp is to develop leadership skills and encourage involvement in scouting by introducing campers to outdoor activities like swimming, archery, and marksmanship.
