

Keithville man accused of using elderly victim's ID to commit crimes

A Keithville man is in jail for using a 72-year-old woman's personal information to obtain credit cards for his personal use, said Sheriff Steve Prator.

Donald Ducharme, 34, is accused of obtaining five credit cards using the victim's identity. He is also accused of using three of her credit cards without her permission.

Sheriff's Detective Casey Jones said the two were acquainted through family members. So far, the loss reported is \$10,038.

Ducharme was booked into the Caddo Correctional Center for theft of the assets of an aged or disabled person and identify theft. He was also booked on a warrant obtained through the Caddo District Attorney's Office for issuing worthless checks.
