

Mooringsport woman arrested on drug, driving charges

A 25-year-old Mooringsport woman was arrested over the weekend for driving violations and drug charges.

Caddo Sheriff's Deputy Dexter White was driving on Interstate 20 Saturday night when he observed Ashley Lynette Reeves traveling westbound, weaving her vehicle from side to side while almost striking another driver.

White conducted a traffic stop and discovered four marijuana cigarettes, 10 Hydrocodone pills, and 21 Xanax pills in Reeves' possession. The vehicle also had a switched license plate.

Reeves was booked into Caddo Correctional Center for possession of schedule I, III, and IV drugs. She was also arrested for DWI, having switched plates, and for improper lane usage.
