

Man arrested for witness intimidation

Caddo deputies arrested a man for witness intimidation after he approached a woman about information she provided in a juvenile case.

Michael Davis, 31, of the 9900 block of Chaffee Heights, is accused of contacting the witness at a local truck stop about a week after the case was in court. Davis clinched his fists while confronting the witness about her statements. The witness, who was in fear for her safety, left the truck stop but was followed by Davis to a friend's house. The confrontation continued, and the Sheriff's Office was called, but Davis left the scene before deputies arrived.

The intimidation case was investigated by Detective Jackie Winston, who arrested Davis on Tuesday. Davis was booked into Caddo Correctional Center.
