

Terrance Lyons back in custody

A Department of Corrections inmate who walked away from a work assignment in November has been taken into custody.

Terrance Lee Lyons, 27, walked away from his job at a maintenance facility in the 1500 block of Monty Street on November 25. He was only nine days shy of being released from jail after serving time for simple assault, probation violation, and motor vehicle offenses.

Just after 6 a.m. today, Lyons was located by state Probation and Parole officers at a residence in the 2600 block of Morningside in Shreveport. He was taken into custody while trying to escape through a back window after officers arrived at the house and knocked on the door.

Lyons was booked into the Caddo Correctional Center for simple escape. His bond has been set at \$5,000.
