

Caddo Sheriff awards scholarship to Captain Shreve senior

Caddo Sheriff Steve Prator awarded an academic scholarship to Ty'Asia Mahoney this morning during a presentation at Government Plaza.

Mahoney is a graduating senior at Captain Shreve High School where she earned a 4.5 grade point average. She will use the \$500 scholarship to study psychology/pre-med at Louisiana State University. Mahoney is the daughter of Kimberly Mahoney of Shreveport.

Mahoney was chosen to receive Caddo's scholarship based on academic achievement, leadership, and character. At Captain Shreve, she was a distinguished scholar, member of the National Honor Society and National English Honor Society.
