

# Man charged with injuring toddler

A Shreveport man is in jail today charged with injuring a two-year-old girl, said Caddo Sheriff Steve Prator.

Jason M. Mattingly, 30, is accused of causing injuries to the child's face and buttocks while she was in his care on August 29. The child was taken by her mother to a local hospital where she was admitted and is still receiving care.

Mattingly was arrested on Monday following an investigation by the Sheriff's Office Patrol and Criminal Investigations Divisions. He was booked into Caddo Correctional Center for second-degree cruelty to juveniles.

Investigating the case were Cpl. Jermaine Kelly, Sgt. Andy Scoggins, and Det. Chris Ardoin.
