## **Caddo Sheriff offers Live Scan fingerprinting service**

Live Scan digital fingerprinting is now available to private employers, state agencies, and other entities through the Caddo Parish Sheriff's Office, said Caddo Sheriff Steve Prator.

With Live Scan, fingerprints are captured electronically and submitted to the Federal Bureau of Investigations and the Louisiana Department of Public Safety to positively identify and provide background checks on prospective employees or agents.

Fingerprinting services are conducted between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday in the Caddo Sheriff's Records Division at the Caddo Parish Courthouse, 501 Texas Street in Shreveport.
