- 5. Stephanie Sansoucie, Dub's Texaco, 120 S. Pine Street, Vivian.

All five received a summons for Unlawful Sales to Persons Under 21. Douglas, Roberts, Lewis, and Sansoucie also received a summons for not possessing an ABO card.
