R.E.D. F.L.A.G.S. is a guide to identifying behaviors that may signal abuse:

- Recognize changes in behavior
- Engage in open conversation
- Document unusual events or comments
- Fear of certain people
- Lack of boundaries
- Avoidance of physical contact
- Gifts or secrets from adults
- Sexualized behavior or knowledge beyond age
