The Safety Town After-School Program will be held Mondays through Thursdays from 3 to 5 p.m., September 8 through November 19, and is open to youth up to 17 years old.

Throughout the program, students will take part in activities and lessons designed to help them make safe decisions at home, at school, online, and in the community. Topics will include gun safety, fire safety, CPR, weather safety, situational awareness, internet safety, peer pressure resistance, saying no to strangers, and careers in law enforcement.
