

Underage alcohol operation nets 1 arrest

Caddo sheriff's deputies checked 22 businesses recently for compliance with laws governing the sale of alcohol to underage persons, but only one was found in violation, said Caddo Sheriff Steve Prator.

Shantel S. Cook, 31, an employee of Elsie's Truck Stop in the 7100 block of Hwy. 1 in Blanchard, was issued a citation for selling alcohol to a person under the age of 21.
