

Local business makes donation to the Caddo-Shreveport Narcotics Task Force

SPF Depot of Bossier City recently donated safety gear for agents when investigating methamphetamine labs. The donation included two full face masks, filter cartridges, shield protectors, disposable overalls with hood and boots, rubber gloves, cool vests, and other items. Retail value of the items is \$700.

SPF Depot has been in business for three years and has a 10,000-foot manufacturing, assembly and packaging facility.
